I George Ham of the County of Amelia being in
Perfect Health both of Body and mind do make this
my Last will and Testament, I Give to my beloved Wife
One Negro by name Tom and one Negro Wench named
Amy During the Term of her Widowhood, and when my
beloved Son John Foster Ham comes of Age, and then
the above mentioned Negroes not to be sold but to be
Equally divided between my Wife Mary and my above
mentioned Son John Foster Ham. Also I Give to my
beloved Wife During her Life Seventy Five Acres being
the Plantation on which I now Live, - after my Wife's
Death I Give it to my Beloved Son John Foster Ham.
Also I Give to my Beloved Son Josiah Ham
a sufficient Maintenance out of the above mentioned
Estate. I also Give him one Negro boy named Pleasant
During his Life. Also I appoint my Brother
William Ham and my beloved Wife Mary Ham
and Francis Foster and Edward Booker my whole
Executors of Personal & Real Estate In
Witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and
Seal this Twenty Eight Day of August 1780
