Amelia County and Parish of Newbury, being weak
in body but of sound Memory (Blessed be God) do make
this my last Will and Testament in Manner following
that is to say —

First. I lend to my beloved Wife Ann Winfree during
of her Natural Life all the Land with my Plantation
Lying the Lower side of the Road the Road being the
Line. Also lend her my Negro Man Tom. Dick, Jean
& Hannah. with all my Stock & furniture Except
what is hereafter Mentioned in lieu of her Right
of Dower

Item I give unto my son Charles Winfree a Negro
Boy James to him & his Heirs for ever.

I give unto my Daughter Mary Casley Winfree
Phellis & Mary they and their Increase to her & her
Heirs for ever

I give unto my Daughter Ann Beasley Negro Wench
Cate. with her Child Sam. She and her Increase
Hereafter to her and her Heirs for ever.

I give unto my Son Robert Winfree the upper part
of my Land. I now live on that is to say all the Land
with the plantation where he now lives the Road
being the Line. with a Negro boy Peter to him and
his Heirs for ever.

I give to my Daughter Susannah Winfree Negro girl
dilly. she and her Increase. to her & her Heirs forever.

I give unto my Son Isaac Winfree the lower part of
the Tract of Land I now live on (the Road being
the Line between my son Robert and Isaac) after
the Death of my wife with a Negro girl Silas to her
& his Heirs for ever.

I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Winfree
Negro Girl Dickey, with her Increase to her
and her Heirs forever

My Will and desire is that my Children as
they Marry or come of Age shall have Each
of them a Cow and Calf. also a bed and furniture.

My desire is that my Daughter Susannah.
Isaac & Elizabeth. shall Each of them have
a horse out of my Estate of Value £12. in gold,
I also will & desire that at the death of my
Wife. that Negro. Tom, Dick. Jean. &
Hannah with there Increase be Equally
Divided between my Son Charles, Robert,
Susannah, Isaac & Elizabeth Winfree
which I give to them and their Heirs
forever. And the Residue of my Stocks of
Horses. Cattle. Sheep Hogs &c with all
the Household furniture of what kind
soever, be Equally divided between Charles.
Mary Casley, Ann Bearley, Robert, Susannah.
Isaac & Elizabeth Winfree to them and
their Heirs forever.

My will & desire is that if my son Isaac
Winfree die before he becomes of Age that the
land I give with the stock and furniture be
sold and the money arising from the sale
thereof. to be Equally divided between my son
Charles. Mary Casley. Ann Bearley, Robert,
Susannah, & Elizabeth to them and their
Heirs forever.

I appoint and ordain my son Charles,
& Robert Winfree Executors of this will.
