Robertson of Amelia County being sick and
Weak but in perfect mind & memory do make and
Ordain this my last will & Testament in manner
an form following Vizt: —

Item I give and bequeath to my son Wornings,
Peter Robertson my Mill tract of Land lying
on both sides the falls of little Rottoway contain-
ing by patent nine hundred and Seventy Acres
More or less also my Mills and batting Cloth on
the falls also my Will and desire is that if my
Wife should want bread to support her Children
Whilst they are raising under her that she be
supply'd with it out of the Mills I also give to
my son Peter two Negroes Miller Joe, and Val one
feather bed and furniture also a small begin-
ning of cattle Sheep and Hogs but if my son
Wornings Peter should die without a lawfull
begotten Heir of his body then my whole estate
Land and Negroes divis'd to him be equally divided
between my three Sons Daniel William Henry
and John Robertson

Item I Lend to my Daughter Susanna Shelton
two Negroes Peg and Puffey and their Increase
during her Natural life I also give the above
Mentioned Negroes and Increase to such of her
Children as she shall nominate in her lifetime —

Item I give and bequeath to my three Sons
David Edward and William Henry Robertson my
Tract of Land containing, Fourteen Hundred Acres
More or less lying in Charlotte County on the
branches of Bupelow & Bluffstone Creeks.

beginning the land of William Robertson James Brown
George Mifflin Kinsley and Drury with lines to be
Equally Divided between them

Item I lend to my Wife Tralucia during her Widow-
hood or life the land and plantation Snow live on
to bring my small children up upon also an Equal
part with her said children of the Slaves hereafter
mentioned. Vizt. Tom Toby Toney Judy and Marcy
which are out at Meherrin also Great Toney Briston
Jimm Charles Joe Song Hanner and Ned also Hannu
Amey Pat Geroy Anthony Isaac Edey Milley
And Sawney Also my stock of Cattle Horses Sheep
and Hogs My furniture of Difrent kinds. also my
Will and desire is that the aforesaid Slaves and
their Future Increase to be Equally Divided between my
Children which I had by her the division to be made
by my Executors when the first Come of Age or Marry's
and so a Division to be made as they come of Age or Marry
one after the other

Item I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Robertson
my Land on the middle fork of Meherrin joining
my son Christopher Robertsons line As judged to be four
Hundred Acres More or less -

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Robertson the
plantation whereon Snow live when he Comes of
Age, also my Butterwood tract of land to be sold at
the Direction of my Executors and the Money arising
to be Equally Divided between my five above mentioned
Sons.

Item My Will and desire is that if other one of
the above mentioned Brothers should die with

a lawfull bequest here of the same that the same
divided to them. to be Equally divided between the
Surviving Brothers above mentioned, it is my
desire that my Executors shall receive the crops
and lay them out as they think proper for the
Advantage of the Children. Also it is my desire
that any Bond that shall become due
hereafter shall be at the discretion of my
Executors to Lay out or put to interest as they
shall think proper and shall be equally
Divided between my two son Daniel and
John Robertson when either of them shall
come of age, also it is my desire that there
shall be no appraisment of my Estate.

Item I do hereby revoke & disanul all other
wills by me made. Confirming, this to be
my last Will and Testament and appoint
my two sons Christopher and Waring,
John Robertson Executors to this my last
Will and Testament. In Witness whereof
I do hereunto set my hand & affix my seal this
Twenty seventh day of October One thousand seven
hundred and Eighty one.
