dispose of the same in the following Manner
& Form.

I promise I give & Bequeath to my Sister
Susannah Vasser, all my land in Lunenburg
County containing One hundred & twenty five
Acres more or less it being the tract of Land
will'd & devised to me by the last will'd
Testament of my Father Jon as Vasser dec'd To her
and the Heir of her Body Lawfully begotten,
and if she the said Susannah Vasser should die
without such Heir then the said land to be
equally divided between my Brothers then living;
Item I give to my Niece, Betsy Vasser daughter
of Jno Vasser dec'd all my other Estate of every
denomination or kind whatsoever to her and her
Heirs forever, but the Cash due to me when
collected to be applied by my Executor for the schooling
of her the said Betsy Vasser.

Lastly I constitute and appoint my Friend
Richd Jones Junior my only & Sole Executor to
this my last will & Testament.
