Imprimis I give & Bequeath to my Sister
Susannah Verser, all my land in Lunenburg
County containing One hundred & twenty five
Acres more or less it being the tract of Land
will'd & devis'd to me by the last will &
Testament of my Father Jon as Verser died To her
and the Heir of her Body Lawfully begotten,
and if she the said Susannah Verser should die
without such Heir then the said land to be
equally divided between my Brothers then living.
Item I give to my Niece, Betsey Verser daughter
of Jesse Verser died all my other Estate of every
denomination or kind whatsoever to her and her
Heirs forever, but the Cash due to me when
collected to be applyed by my Executor for the schooling
of her the said Betsey Verser.

Lastly I constitute and appoint my Friend
Rich Jones Junior my only & Sole Executor to
this my last will & Testament.
