to be my last will and Testament in Manner and
form following

I give and bequeath to John Malone my Bay
Horse Saddle and Bridle and all the Debt that he is
owing me to him and his Heirs for ever

I give to my Niece Dorothy Hamlin Morgan my soul
riding Horse to her and her Heirs for ever

I give and bequeath to Sister Lucy Powell Fifty Pounds
specie to her and her Heirs for ever

I give and bequeath to my Brother in Law Samuel
Morgan husband to my sister Putter Morgan and to
his Heirs for ever my Land and Plantation in America
County that I have of John Malone and likewise my
three Negroes to wit, Joe, Tom, & Jack and all the rest
of my Estate of what kind soever out of which he is to
pay all my just Debts and the Fifty pounds I have be
fore given to my sister Lucy Powell

Lastly I do appoint the said Samuel Morgan my
Executor of this my last Will and Testament and desire
that my Estate may not be appraised in witnesses
