the Property of William Townes and if my said
Wife will and does make my son John Rayall a good &
Lawful Heir unto the said Land in fee then my Will
and desire is that the Land I have given to be divided among Four
of my sons be equally Divided among Three namely Richard
Joseph Archer and William Rayalls to them and their Heirs
For Ever

Item I give unto my beloved Wife Mary E. Rayall all my
House hold and Kitchen furniture also half of my stock
Hens cattle sheep and Hogs.

Item I give unto William Archer son of John Archer & half
Brother to my Wife one Negroe boy named Hardness
to him and his heirs forever.

Item the Residue of my Estate real and personal I give
to be Equally divided among my six children namely
John Elizabeth Richard Joseph Archer William and
James Rayalls each to take their Respective parts as
they come to age or marry but if either of my child-
ren above named should not arrive to the age of
Twenty one years or marry then my will is that my
Estate be divided equally among the surviving ones
except my Land which my Will is shall be divided
among my male children equally, it is my Will
that my Estate may not be oppressed Lastly I give
