saplin S 60 W. 193 poles to a corner Butterwood on the head of Valls branch
thence down the S. Branch as it meanders to Little Notoway River thence
up the S. River as it meanders to the Beginning Given under our hands
this twenty first day of Aug^r. 1781

of, as tho she had married lawfully
