this my Last Will and Testament — I Give & bequeath to my love
wife Elizabeth Featherstone one negro woman named Aggy, one neg-
boy nam'd Dick, one negro boy nam'd Dege, one negro boy nam'd Jim
one Feather bed & Furniture one half of my Stock of horses, cattle hogs
sheep also one blue wide saddle which she has in possession also all the
Fowler that came by her, all which I give to her to dispose of as she shall
think proper I also lend to my Loving wife Elizabeth one negro man —
nam'd Joe, one Negro man nam'd Sam, one Negro man nam'd Ben
all which I lend her during her widowhood
I Give & bequeath to my brother Charles Howel Featherstone one
Negro man nam'd David also one Feather Bed & Furniture also all
my Fowler that I have not already given also all my Stock of cattle
horses, hogs & sheep that I have not already given also two brass
mounted Guns also my black Smiths tools all which I give to him —
when he comes of Age or marries all which I give to him & his heirs
forever — It is further my desire, that the three negroes that I have
Lent my wife and all the rest of my estate that I have not already
given may be Equally divided between all my brothers & sisters, it is
my Will and Desire that my estate may not be Appraised, and lastly
I do Appoint my brother William Featherstone & Charles Featherstone
my Executors of this my Last Will and Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this fourteenth day Jan^y 1781
