Tucker Son of the bounty of Amelia being Sane and of sound
body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed
be to god for the same I do make and publish this my
last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit
First I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter
Phibe Tucker One negro by all names I shall give her as of
bath One bed and furniture and things and if she shall
I shall should have any children for Phibe Tucker to be as
she pleases with and also her bath and bed during her life and
after her decease the same I shall to my son Matthew Tucker to have
and his heirs forever. Secondly I give and bequeath unto
my Son Thomas Tucker the plantation whereon I now live
to him and his heirs forever. Thirdly I give and bequeath

and my Loving Son Henry Tucker and part of land as his own property
with to him and his heirs forever. I do constitute and appoint my
Said Son Matthew Tucker and Absalom Tucker Sole Executors of
this my Last will my desire is for what of my Estate is not
above mentioned for to be equally divided amongs the whole of
Children and do hereby revoke and make void all other will by
me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand affixed my Seal this third day of March in the year
Of our Lord 1784.
