In the name of god amen I Moses Hunt of the County
of Amelia and Parish of Stollow being sick and weak but of per-
fect mind and memory thanks be unto almighty god for the same
and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing
it is ordained for all men to die do in my proper senses
Constitute and appoint this my Last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all other Will or Wills whatsoever made by me on for
me and with. What Estate it hath Pleased almighty god
to bless me with I give and bequeath in manner and form following
Viz. my Will and desire is that all my Just debts and funeral
Expences be first Paid by my Executors.
Item I give and bequeath to my Loving Daughters Mellecent
Chambis Eighty Pounds current money or as before Twelve
Months after my Decease and also my Still to her.

Now for ever

I now give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Elizabeth. What the Negro Woman Hannah and her Children that she has in Possession and also old Hannah and their future Increase also Two Cows to her and her heirs for ever.

I now give and bequeath to my Loving Son Moses Hunt four Negroes Viz. Ben. and Daniel that he has in Possession also old Sam & Phoe to him and his heirs for ever

I now I do hereby send to my Loving Daughter Sarah Juby during her Natural Life six Negroes Viz Solomon, bejs Isaac, young Sam, and George, for the purpose of Supporting of Supporting herself and Educating and Supporting her Children and maintaining them and my Will and desire is that W.^m Juby her husband, have no right of Possession Authority Control or blame of any Service of the said Negroes in any manner.

Whatsoever but that the soul Labour of the said Negroes be for the only Purpose aforesaid and after the death of my Daughter Sarah Juby my Will and Desire is that the said six Negroes be Equally divided amongst all her Children that now have may have to them and to their heirs for ever together with the Increase of them I also send her for the use of the said Children one Ox and Furniture and I give her if I die before there is a nother crop one tenth part of the Crops of Corn Tobacco and Cotton that is made this year 1723

I give and bequeath to my Loving Son Zachus Hunt the following Negroes Viz. Sam son of Phoe Dock Tomor and her Children Phil. Joseph. and Reubin. and their future Increase also one Stud Horse to him and his heirs for ever

I also give him one hundred Acres of Land Part of the Tract Inawdive on Beginning at the mouth of the bear branch

thence up the River as it meanders to the mouth of my spring Branch thence up the C. Branch to my spring from thence.

As much as I am able to do I give to him the same amount of land as
he has for ever I also give and bequeath to him the Plantation and land
whereon he now lives containing by Estimation one hundred acres
Fifty Two acres being a Tract Purchased of Daniel Shelton be the same more
or less to him and his heirs for ever.

I then Give and bequeath to my Living Son Absalom Hunt the same
part of the Tract of Land now here on containing by Esti-
mation Two hundred acres be the same more or less together
With all its appurtenances except a Mill to him and his heirs
for ever. I also give him six Negroes and their future in-
crease Viz Will, David, Jenny, Frances, Susannah, and Puff,
to him and his heirs for ever.

I then Give and bequeath to my Living grand Daughter
Martha Hunt six Negroes Viz Chloe Lewis James Paul and
Charity and their future increase but if she dies leaving
no Issue then my Will and desire is that the said Negroes
and their future Increase be equally divided amongst my five Children
or the Survivors of them. Elizabeth White Mose Hunt Sarah
Isby Zacharias Hunt and Absalom Hunt. If she dies leaving issue
then my Will is that she have the said Negroes and her heirs for ever
but if she dies not then my Will and desire is that my said
five Children and their heirs for ever ^{have} them as aforesaid and
their heirs for ever. I also give my said Living grand Daughter
the Vattain Gilley one head and furniture to her & her heirs
For ever.

I then my Will and desire is that all my Negroes and Stock
of all kind be kept all on my manner Plantation except
such as have particularly mentioned to my Children or my
grand Daughter for the purpose of making a crop to pay the
Legacy I have given to my daughter Millicent Chambers and
that my Daughter Sarah Isby have Leave to work her negroes
in the Crop for as share of it as agreeable to what Slaves the
Put in.

have mentioned in writing but I have not of others.
Kind, I am as equally divided amongst my four children
Viz. Elizabeth White Moses Hunt Sarah Abby Tachens.
Hunt Absolom Hunt and to their heirs for ever.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my living sons
Tachens Hunt Absolom Hunt and my friends
Stephen Locke Executors of this my Last Will &
Testament In Witness Whereof I have to these present
set my hand and seal this seventh day of November
one thousand seven hundred and eighty three
Signed and acknowledged Moses Hunt Senr.
