to my said loving wife all my Estate Real & Perso-
nal to have & enjoy during her widowhood viz
my Land & Plantation in this County whereon I
now live, with the Lands adjoining all my Stock of
Horses, cattle, Sheep, & Hogs, my household Furniture
Money I have on hand & what may be due me at my
Death or owing to me, also the use of every Tool of
Husbandry & all other Estate whatsoever. It is my
desire if my wife Marries the Estate lent her may
be divided among my Children Equally that is to
say my Land & Plantations between my sons
that I may have by my said wife, at her Marriage
the Remainder of my Estate between all my Children
that may be by my said wife; If my wife Marries
it is my desire my Children be maintained out of
my Estate after the Ten Negroes shall be taken from
it, If any of my Children dies before Age or Marriage
the Estate of the Child that death may be Equally divided
between the survivors, It is my desire my wife pay no

that one had to be very reasonable for the purpose
is my desire my Estate be not appraised or my Executors
give any security for their Executorship, I leave my said
loving Wife Executor & my son Richard Pland
Executor to this my last will & Testament wrote with
my own hand & affixed my Name to my seal the
fourteenth day of September One thousand seven
hundred & seventy Nine
Peter Randolph Pland
