Item My will I desire is that my Father & Mother shall have their living out of my Estate during their lives here with me.

Item My will & Intention is that all my Estate both Real & Personal be kept together till all my Children shall come of age or marriage & provided if my wife is with child shall have a Equal Share of my Estate with my wife & the rest of my Children to take their parts at marriage & my wife to have her life in my plantation above.

Item I lastly of all appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Locke and Peter Manson to be my whole Excutrice & Executor of this my last will & Testament Revoking and disannulling all other wills by me made.
