and Testament I give and bequeath my soul to
Almighty god who first give me my body to the
Earth from whence it came as for the Worldly
Which it hath pleased almighty god of his goodness
to bestow on me I give and bequeath in form and
Manner following Item
I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary
Newman the Tract of Land whereon I now live
During her natural life or Widowhood and after
her Death or marriage to my beloved Grand
Son Richard Rice Newman to he and his heirs

I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary Newman Three Negroes to wit one Negro fellow named Peter one Negro Wench named Lucy, and one Negro Wench named Silvey, During her natural life and after her Death the Wench named Silvey and her Increase to Nancy Farlow Daughter of John Farlow to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary Newman one Bed and furniture, and the Fourth Part of all my Cattle and hogs my round Table, blue Chest, and Corner cupboard, the Cups and saucers, tea pot, three Earthen plates, and half the Pewter and after her Death all her Dower Except the Negro Wench named Silvey, to be equally Divided between John Farrow Farlow, and the Children Lawfully begotten of her Body, Item I give and bequeath unto Sarah Sanderfer wife of Samuel Sanderfer one Negro Fellow named Isaac and one Negro Wench named Jinney which is now in possession of Samuel Sanderfer and after her Death to be Equally Divided between the Children Lawfully begotten of her Body.

Item I give and bequeath unto my four Grand Daughters Elizabeth Fowler, Martha Fowler, Rebecca Fowler and Mary Fowler Daughters of Joseph Fowler and Mary Fowler Decedent Three Negro Wenches and

their Increase, Black, White, and Tawney which
Joseph Fowler have in his care until Elizabeth
Fowler arrives to the age of Eighteen Years or
Marriage and to Equally Divided
them I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Daughter Susanah Sanderfer Wife of John
Sanderfer one Negro Wench named Grace and
all her Increase During her life and after her
Death to Elizabeth Sanderfer Daughter of
Susanah Sanderfer and if she the said Elizabeth
Sanderfer should die without Issue her Legacy be
Equally Divided between Newman Ephson of
Joshua Ephs and Rebeckah Sanderfer Daughter of
Samuel Sanderfer them I give and bequeath unto
Lucy Ephs Wife of Joshua Ephs one Negro Fellow
named Glosier and one Negro Wench named
Alley and her Increase to she and her heirs forever
them I give and bequeath unto John Farrow Farlow
Two hundred acres of Land at the Upper End of
Rice Newmans Tract to be sold to the highest
and the money put to Interest until he
arrives to the Age of Twenty One or Marriage
also two Negroes to wit one Negro Boy named
Hall and negro Girl named Lucy Daughter
of Sue, and he the said John Farrow Farlow
should die before he arrives to the Age of Twenty
one or Marriage the whole of his Legacy to be
Equally Divided between Richd. Rice Newman

of Cattle, and hogs after my Wifes Dower and
all the Remaining Part of my Est be it of
what nature or kind soever to be sold to the
highest Bidder at six months Credit and
after my Debts and Legacies and Funeral
Expenses are paid the money arising

therefrom to be Equally Divided amongst the
of my Children And Appoint my beloved Son
Rice Newman and Joshua Epps my Executors to
this my Last Will and Testament In Witness
my hand and affixed my Seal This First Day of
October One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty
two
