Once to die, do make constitute & Appoint this to be my last Will
& Testament humbly giving my soul to Almighty God that gave it me
and my what worldly estate that it hath pleased Almighty God to
bless me with in this life I give & bequeath in manner & form following

estate for the use of her & my two Children Viz John Millener Hudson
and Mary Cobbs Hudson till either of my said Children should come
of Age or marry or my said wife should marry and in either Case that
either of my said Children should come of Age or marry or my said wife
should marry that then in that case I lend to my said wife one Equal third
part of my estate during her life and at her decease all except the land
I give and bequeath to my son John Millener Hudson and my daughter
Mary Cobbs Hudson to be equally divided between them & to them their
heirs & assigns forever - Item I give & bequeath to my son John Millener
Hudson the remaining two thirds parts of my land to him his heirs & assigns
forever I also give to my said son the other part of my land ^{said} At the death of
my Loving Wife - Item all the remaining part of my estate I give &
bequeath to my son John Millener Hudson & my daughter Mary Cobbs Hudson
to be Equally divided between them when either of them shall come of Age or
Marry to them their heirs & assigns forever - Lastly I do hereby Appoint
my friend Edm^d Booker Executor of this my last Will & Testament for
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 20th day of June 1780
