and County of Amelia being in perfect health senses & Memory do make this
my last Will and Testament as (Follows Viz) I lend to my loving Wife Eliza
Collier during her Natural life or Widowhood the Tract of land whereon I
now live, also the Following Negroes to wit, Peter, & greatamey, my Stock of all
kinds & Household Furnitures, I lend her also until my Sons arrive to the Age of
Twenty one Years & my Daughter to the Age of Eighteen or Marry my Tract of
Land in the upper End of this County and the Following Negroes, to wit, John
Red, Sigh, Daniel, Amey, Belinda & Lueky, I give to my wife, during her
Natural life, the two Following Negroes and Increase to wit, Herod & Fanny
my Earnest desire is that my Children may be as well Educated as the profits
of my Estate will Afford. . . . I give to my Daughter Elizabeth W. Price
and her heirs forever an negro girl Named Belinda, and an negro boy Named Sigh
and after the Death of my loving Wife, I also give her an negro boy named Herod
I give to my Son Thomas Price & his heirs forever, an negro Woman named Jude
an negro girl named, Lueky, and after the death or marriage of my loving Wife
I also give him the Tract of Land whereon I now live
I give to my Son John Price & his heirs forever the one half of my upper Tract
of Land, also an negro Woman Named Amey an negro man Named John
after the Death or Marriage of my wife also an negro woman named Amey
my Desire is that the said Tract of Land be divided by a line, run across
and that my S. Son John may take his Choice of the two Tracts . .
I give to my Son Francis Price & his heirs forever the other half of my Tract
of Land also an negro boy named Daniel, and after the death or marriage
of my loving wife I also give him, Negro Peter and Fanny that is to
