3 chests Cotton, Earthen jar carrying Knives Flap hatchets and  
Kilnicks and Wheat Fan wheat sieve, 2 p<sup>ts</sup> saws, 1 Iron  
pots, 1<sup>st</sup> Rack &c, 2 looking glasses, 2 Trunks 2 p<sup>ts</sup> Tongs and

In the name of God I Sarah Motley wife of Joel Motley  
of the County of Amelia do make and ordain this to be my Last will and  
Testament in manner and form as followeth that is to say I give unto my beloved  
husband Joel Motley all my negroes during of his life and after the death of  
my said Husband that then I give all my negroes with all their increase  
unto my said child <sup>some of my body if the said child</sup> should  
live to lawful age or marry to my said child &c. her forever but if no such  
child should ~~live~~ <sup>live</sup> to the age above mentioned that then I give at the death  
of my said Husband all my negroes and their increase as above mentioned  
To be Equally divided between my Brother Moses Coppage and Sally  
Sutton daughter of my Sister Betty Sutton wife of James Sutton to them and  
their heirs forever and lastly I do constitute and appoint my loving Husband  
and my Brother Moses Coppage Executors to this my Last will and Testa-  
ment In witness Whereunto I set my hand and seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1768
