this to be my last will and Testament
as follows

and Sarah Booker five Negroes Viz Sucky and her four
children Provided that he be Living but in case
that he should be dead then I Give them five
Negroes to his Brother Efford Booker I Give to my
Brother John Cobbs one Negroe named Betty
During his Natural life and after his decease
I then Give her to his Daughter Edith Cobbs I Give
to my Brother John Cobbs one Silver Can I Give
to Betty Booker my Silver Spoons and the Rest
of my plate I Give to my Sister Anne Booker
my cattle I Give to my Sister Judith Egglestone
my mare I also Give to my Sister Anne Booker all
my Stock of Hogs I Give to Frances Hill one Bed
and furniture, and my wearing Apparel I Give
may be Divided betwixt all my Sisters Lastly I
appoint my Brother John Cobbs and George
Booker my Executors of this my last will
and Testament In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty
first day of March 1782—
