named & as to such of my temporal estate as it hath pleased God to bless
me with I give & dispose of the same in manner & form as followeth
Nam I give to the heirs of my son Tho. James Decd and likewise to my daugh-
ter Elizabeth Foster wife of Robt Foster one shilling Sterling each . . .
I likewise lend to my beloved wife Martha, one Equal third part of all my
real & personal estate during her life and after her death to descend to
my son John James, and all the remainder of my estate of every kind I
give to my said son John, and Lastly I constitute and Appoint my Son
John James my whole & sole executor to this my last Will & Testament re-
=volving and making void all other wills by me made In witness whereof
I have set my hand & affixed my seal this seventh day of december 1780
