two Daughters Amy & Pattery. The other part of my land
lying the North side of the tanfat branch a joining
low black I give and bequeath to my son Henry and his
Heirs for Ever.

Will Hereby Revoking all others In witness whereof I have
here unto set my hand and fixed my Seal this sixth Day of
May one Thousand seven Hundred and Eighty
