In the Name of God Amen I Henry Dennis of the County of Stafford
 being of sound and disposing mind and Memory do make & ordain this my
 Last Will & Testament in manner and form as followeth
 I hereby give my wife Jane and during her Widowhood all my land and plantation
 and nine Negro Slaves Viz York, Toney, Saul, Talton, Anceky, Sarah
 Doll, Aggy & Daphney, also the Legacy that is or may be due to my
 Estate out of my Deceased Fathers Estate at the death of my Mother
 and all the rest of my Estate of every kind (the Remainder of my
 Estate) and a horse apiece to each of my Sons as they come to age

The whole of the above named Estates, together
due me from the Public or Individuals, be disposed to purchase
for my three Youngest sons, Matthew Jacklin, Richard & Joseph
Egglestone under the direction of my Executors, . . . I then give to
my son Edward a bay horse Coll called Cripple, & to my daughter Judith
a bay mare Coll called Liberty, . . . I then it is my Will and Desire
that all the remainder of my Estate be kept undivided & together
during the life & widowhood of my beloved wife Judith & I do hereby
lend it to my loving wife during her life & widowhood if she should
Choose to marry I desire she may have one third part of my then
Estate, at her death death I do hereby direct that a division be
Immediately made in manner & form hereafter Mentioned . . .

I then give and bequeath to my two eldest sons, William Cary &
Edward Egglestone all the Lands and Tenements & Profits in the
County of Amelia forever to be Equally divided between them at
the death or Marriage of my beloved wife Judith, but after the division
shall be fairly made it is my Will that my Eldest son William Cary
take his Choice without lasting lots, I then give and bequeath all
my Personal Estate consisting of Negroes Stock &c. to all my Children
William Cary, Edward, Matthew Jacklin, Richard, Judith, Ann. & Joseph
Egglestone, to be equally divided between them at the death or Marriage
of my beloved wife Judith, I then It is my Will and desire that out of the
Profits of the estate which I have by this my last Will and Testament
directed to be kept together, a horse Saddle & bridle shall be furnished
to each of my Sons, Matthew Jacklin and Joseph on their Severally
Arriving at the Age of twenty one years, & to my daughter Anne on her
Arriving at the Age of sixteen years, It is also my wish that a saddle
& Bridle should be furnished my daughter Judith on her Attaining the
Age of 16 years; I then it is my Will and Desire that my Son Joseph
and my daughter Anne be educated out of the profits of the Estate I
have directed to be kept together, It is my wish that my Son Joseph
should be kept at school till he arrives at the Age of sixteen years; &
if the Estate should by this my last will & Testament be divided before
he arrives at that Age I do hereby direct that he be educated at the
Joint Expence of all my Sons, after he arrives at that age it is my will
that he be employed in some business which may best suit his talents

Still he arrives at the Age of twenty one years

I then give and bequeath to my Sons Matthew Jacklin & Richard all the Carpenters & Joiners Tools which I may die possessed off, to be equally divided between them on their Arriving at the Age of twenty one years

Item it is my Will and desire that, if the profits of the Estate I have left undivided should be greater than will defray the Charges before fixed by this Testament the overplus be Applied by the Executors to the purchase of land for my three Sons, Matthew Jacklin, Richard & Joseph, bearing in mind that it is not my Intention that more of the profits be Applied to the use of these three Sons than will make up their Tracts to 300 Acres each. Item I do hereby direct that if either of the Legatees by this my Testament, should die before the Age of twenty one years in that case the part of him or her be equally divided among the Surviving Legatees.

I Appoint as Executors to this my last Will and Testament my beloved Wife Judith Egglestone, Joseph Egglestone my Brother, Richard Egglestone ^{sr} of the County of Cochran, Joseph Egglestone ^{sr} William Cary Egglestone, and Edward Egglestone,

Egglestone & Edward after the Mother's death that they may take one Sister to live with one and the other with the other Brother as long as they live Single & the
