my last Will and Testament. First I give my soul to  
almighty god who first gave it me and body to  
the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executors  
and my worldly Estate the same hath blessed me with

Having all my Estate I now enjoy both Real and personal  
during her natural life. I now give and bequeath unto my  
son Stephen all the land I now possess also two negroes named  
Ben and Joe Bay to him and his heirs forever.  
I now give and bequeath unto my son Stuart Farley one  
Negro man named Bobb; I now give unto my son Daniel  
Farley one negro named Jemmy to him and his heirs  
For Ever. I give and bequeath unto my son William  
Farley one negro named Lewis to him and his heirs for  
Ever. I now give and bequeath unto my daughter Hannah  
one negro named Suckey also one bed and Furniture  
as it stand commonly called her bed to her & her heirs  
For Ever. I now give and bequeath unto my daughter  
Betty Sheat one negro named Bloo to her and her heirs  
Forever. I now give and bequeath unto my Daughter  
in Law Sarah Farley one negro named Nance to her  
and her heirs forever and all the rest of my Estate  
To be Equally Divided amongst all my Legacies the  
moneys to them and their heirs forever. I appoint  
my son Stephen Farley and my son Daniel Farley my  
Whole and sole Executors of this my Last Will and Testa-  
ment hereby Revoking & annulling all other wills  
by me made formerly I Witness whereof I have here-  
unto set my hand and affixed my seal this 18<sup>th</sup> day of  
November one thousand seven hundred & eighty seven
