-wood thence N. 60 E 193 poles to a hickory saplin, S 27 E poles to a  
Sweet Gum on Little branch, thence down the S. branch as it meanders  
to Wallaces line and thence along his line N. 54 E poles to the begin-  
-ning Given under our hands this twenty first Aug<sup>st</sup> 1781

Line N. 80 E. 98 poles to two Red Oaks N. 2 W. 96 poles to Hendersons cor-  
ner thence along Hendersons line E 120 poles to a Hickory thence along  
Hudsons Old line N. 80 E. 210 poles to a red Oak, on the middle fork of  
Woody Creek, thence along new Divisions line S. 172 poles to a hickory  
saplin S 60 W. 193 poles to a corner Butterwood on the head of Valls branch  
thence down the S. Branch as it meanders to Little Notoway River thence
