Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Wal
hall one Negro woman Named Isabella and her
Two Children Daron and Sarah which he hath now
In Possession I also give unto my said son William
Mat a negro boy and Icham and The Future increase
of Isabella and Sarah all which I give to my said
son William and his heirs forever -

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Walhall
the Land and Plantation wherein he now lives that
is to say beginning at Boulds Branch we have about
Branch empty into it from thence up the & about Branch
as it meanders to the Road including all the Land & Hole
to the westward of the said Branch that belongs to the said
Tract wherein I now live supposed to be eighty acres -
I also give and bequeath to my said son Robert four
negroes to wit; Nathan old Tom & Aggy and her
son Jesse and the future Increase of the said Aggy
all which I give to him & his heirs forever -

Item I give unto my Daughter Mary Morgan two negroes
to wit; Major and Sela During her natural life and
the future Increase of the said Sela and at her death

Increase of the said child and my Grandson William Morgan
and I mean my said Grandson William Morgan should die
before he comes of age or marries and my said Daughter
Mary Morgan should not have another Child then my Will
and desire is that the said Major & Sila should receive with
the future Increase of Sila to be equally Divided between my three
Sons William Robert and Branch Walcott but in case my
Before mentioned Daughter Mary Morgan should have
another Child then my Will and desire is that in case
the before mentioned William Morgan should die without
lawful Heir that the said Major and Sila with the future
Increase of Sila may Retain to such Child whether male
or female. -- I then Give to my daughter Frances &c
Four Negroes to wit Sarah and her three Children
which she now hath in possession during her natural
Life and at her death my Will and desire is that the said
negroes before mentioned with their future Increase may be

I then Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Morgan
two negroes namely Sarah and Peggy with their future Increase

Negroes to wit Winnie and John with the future Increase
of Winnie all which I give to her & her Heirs Forever.....
I then Give and bequeath to my Daughter Lucy Walcott to

Lucy should die before the times of lawful age or marriage then
my Will and desire is that the said Tom and Betsey with the
Future Success of Betsey may be Equally divided between my

Suit of Dress & what I give to my said daughter Lucy and
the same forever that is to say the same to keep lawful age
or married and if not to be divided Equally between the
said Martha Old & Betsey Morgan & Martha Old
I humbly unite my beloved Wife Betty the Land & Plan-
tation I purchased of Charles who was Three years & 6 weeks
with John Frank. and amey with their future Successors
Boy was called a little but one year & 6 weeks in head
of her of a year old Fifteen Barrels of Corn and ten
Bushels of Wheat all which I give her during her natural
life or widowhood and at her death or marriage
I give and bequeath the said Tract of Land unto my
son branch Walshall to him and his heirs forever & at
the said Period of her death or marriage I give more
to my son Robert Walshall Frank To my daughter
Martha Old and amey to my daughter Lucy Wal-
shall all which I give to them and their heirs forever
and the above mentioned Stock and Grain I give to my
said Wife Betty and to her heirs Forever
Then I give and bequeath unto my son branch Walshall
the Land and plantation whereon I now live containing

I give that it not before mentioned Except a bow & ball & that
I give to my Daughter Lucy Wallhall my Will and a Desire is
that In case my said son Branch Should die before he come
of the age of nineteen years of marring that sixty acres of land
beginning at Birds Branch where Joseph Birds line comes
of from the great Branch From thence To The Creek to
Include the said sixty acres Which I give to my son William
Wallhall his heirs and assigns Forever & the Remainder
Part of the Land & Plantations I give to my son Robert Wal-
thall and his heirs for ever in case my son Branch should
die before the time above mentioned and In case my son
Branch should die before the time as aforesaid I give the
Tract of Land Lent my Wife unto Charles Old & his heirs
Forever - and then to my Daughter Lucy Anna; to my
Daughter Elizabeth Morgan and a son Peter Bettermaney
with the future Increase of both & Nancy to be Equally divided
between my two sons William & Robert Wallhall & the
Stock of Every kind whatsoever with the household furniture
I give Equally divided between my Four daughters
Mary Morgan. Elizabeth Morgan Martha Old and
Lucy Wallhall.

Item I give and bequeath unto Benjamin Wallhall son
of my former wife twenty Free Pounds current money
In case he arrives to the age of twenty one years to be paid
out of the property left my son Branch but in case
he should die before the time aforesaid for it contin-
ue in the said Estate Lastly I appoint my three sons
William, Robert & Branch Wallhall Executors of this
my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this 2 day Nov^r 1740
