I Alexander Fisher of y<sup>e</sup> County of Amelia being very sick and  
weak in Body but of perfect Mind and Memory Thanks be given to  
God. But knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die do  
Make and ordain this to be my last Will & Testament

That is to say first of all I recommend my Soul to God y<sup>e</sup> gave it and my Body  
to be buried in Decent order at y<sup>e</sup> Discretion of my Executors. Secondly  
lacking such worldly goods as it hath pleased God to bless me with in  
this life I dispose of them in the following manner. First I Give and  
Bequeath to Jean my dearest beloved Wife y<sup>e</sup> place I now live on  
during her life as also her third part of all the movables and household  
Goods. Viz. after y<sup>e</sup> lawfull is discharged. 2. ly. I Give and bequeath  
to my well beloved Son John Two hundred and thirty five Acres of  
Land joining George Daviges place also the Bay meers. Cott now  
of on year lide and my Gun. 3. ly. I Give and Bequeath to my well  
beloved Son Alexander Two hundred and thirty five Acres of Land  
joining a Bbs place. 4. ly. I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved  
Son James Two hundred Acres. Viz. y<sup>e</sup> place I now live on and that at  
the Death of my mother. 5. ly. I Give and Bequeath to my well  
beloved

I do hereby give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Forty five pounds, which is to be paid as follows when I  
 Samuel comes of age Vizt my son John is pay him fifteen pounds and also  
 Alexander and James each of them to pay fifteen pounds apiece. 6. by I give  
 to my well beloved Daughters Vizt Agnes Catharine Mary Susanna,  
 the other two thirds of my moveables and Household goods Equally to be  
 divided amongst them. I likewise constitute and ordaine my well beloved  
 Wife Jane to be my sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament  
 and do hereby revoke and disannule all other Wills by me made y<sup>e</sup> day  
 and year above written
