my Soul to Godomercy & my Estate as followeth:
Item I lend to my dearly beloved Wife Elizabeth Tan-
nan the plantation where I now live & all my hogs
& cattle & Household furniture during her Widow-
hood & if I give her my Horse saddle & Bridle
and the land I have left to my Wife after her de-
cease to be equally divided between my Son Laugh-
lin and my Son Phillip Beginning to divide at the
burchin where my line & nagassee crosses if either of
them dies without heir the other to possess the whole
& if both dies without heir to my son Achillis Tannan
Laughlins part to be joining the Burchen & spring
branch in the fork. Item I give to my son John
Tannan all the land that lies on the East side of
my spring branch only about half an acre
joining the spring to keep it good not to sell till
his Mothers death nor more. Item I leave all my
land that lies on the south side of the burchen to be
sold by my Executors to discharge my Debts if any

land that lies on the south side of the church to be
sold by my Executors to discharge my Debt if any
Left of the money the said land sold for beside pay-
ing my Debt to be equally divided between my Son
daughlin & my Son Phillips and my daughter
Judith also after my Wifes time the Hogs & cattle
& Household furniture to be equally divided amongst
the same three Children daughlin Phillips & Judith
Item I leave to my Children David Mary Bryan Anna
Betty Peggy & fräney one shilling a piece.
Item I do hereby make constitute & appoint my
beloved Wife Elizabeth Tannan & my Son Achillis
Tannan Executors of my last Will & Testament
intestate of all I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal
this 3 day of January 1765
