same be divided then by my Friend George Worham if alive but
if Dead by my Friend Benjamin Watkins & desire that so much
as I have already given to my son Robin in Possession be regarded &
understood as part of my Estate in the said Division & Allotment
But in case either of my said two sons Robert & Thomas shall
depart this life before my said son Thomas shall arrive to the age of
twenty one years then my Will is that my personal Estate of every kind
do go & belong to the said Survivor And lastly my Will is & I accor-
dingly order & direct that my said two sons in consideration of the
aforesaid legacies do pay to my four Daughters Agnes Mary
Phebe & Ann twenty five Pounds each when arrived at the age of
eighteen or married respectively that is to say my said son
Robert,
