Amelia County Wills 1734-1761
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being very Sick and Weak do make ~~this~~ my last Will and Testament and doe leave my Estate as followeth

First I leave to my grandson James Brannan one year and two Cow Yearlings And to my grandson Thomas Brannan One Cow Yearling And to my grandson Ezer Brannan One Cow Yearling And my Eldest and only Daughter Catharine Brannan during her life And then to her Son John Brannan And all the Remainder of my Estate and Debts I leave to my Son in Law Thos Brannan after my Death And I charge my Son Thomas to see that he be my Executor

February 25th 1754
