

In the name of God Amen I Edward Tanner of the
Parish of Raighley and County of Amelia being sick and weak
but of perfect Mind and Memory do make and Ordain this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth
Item I give and bequeath to my loving Wife One Feather bed &
Furniture also my Black Horse and Side Saddle and Bridle and
the use of my Plantation during her life or Widdowhood
Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Coleman One Shilling Sterling
and all other necessaries which she hath in her Profession
Item I give to my Daughter Jane Coleman One Shilling Sterling
and all other necessaries which she hath in her profession
Item I give and bequeath to my Son Robert Tanner One Shilling
Sterling and all other necessaries which he hath in his profession
Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Clay One Shilling
Sterling and all other necessaries which she hath in her profession
Item I give and bequeath to my Son Field Tanner all my Land
from his Brother Robert's side to the Back line containing One
hundred and seventy Acres be the same more or less including
the Plantation to him and his heirs forever
Item I leave to be sold the Two hundred and eight Acres of Land

the Plantation to him and his heirs forever
Item I leave to be sold the Two hundred and eight Acres of Land
which I hold in Mecklingburg and the Money to be Equally
Divided between Jeremiah Tanner and Edward Tanner And
then I leave all the rest of my Estate whatsoever to be sold at a
Twelve Months Credit and the Money to be Equally Divided after
my Debts be paid between Jeremiah Tanner Edward Tanner Field
Tanner Milley Tanner and Martha Tanner and last of all I do
Appoint my Son Jeremiah Tanner and Robert Tanner Executors to this
my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal this Twelfth Day of December 1769
