his heirs for ever

I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved Daughter
Richard Jones the Feather Bed and Furniture whereon
I now lie, all my wearing Apparel, both Lining and
woolens and one Dozen of the Newest Deep Colored
Dresses to her and her heirs for ever

I Give and Bequeath to my grandson Thomas Corlies, and
Thomas Corlies twenty Shillings to buy him a gold
Ring to him and his heirs for ever

I Give to my grand Daughter Elizabeth Marston Green
Daughter of Thomas Green twenty Shillings to buy her
a gold Morning Ring to her and her heirs for ever

I Give to my Loving Daughter Elizabeth Cheatham twenty
Shillings to buy her a gold Ring

ing Hundred and Fifty Acres, be the same more or less,
lying and being in Amelia County, and joining the line

Richard Jones the Feather Bed and Furniture whereon
I now lie, all my wearing Apparel, both Lining and
wooden and one Dozen of the Newest Deep Red
Plates to her and her Heirs forever.

m I Give and Bequeath to my grandson Thomas Corlies, son of
Thomas Corlies twenty Shillings to buy him a gold
Ring to him and his Heirs forever.

m I Give to my grand Daughter Elizabeth Marston Green
Daughter of Thomas Green Twenty shillings to buy her
a gold Morning Ring to her and her Heirs forever.

m I Give ^{to my} ~~to my~~ Loving Daughter Elizabeth Cheetham twenty
Shillings to buy her a gold Ring.

m I Give and Bequeath to my Loving Daughter Lucy Clay twenty
Shillings to buy her a gold Ring.

40 m I Give and Bequeath to my Loving Daughter Martha Clay
Twenty Shillings to buy her a gold Ring.

40 m I Give and Bequeath to my Loving son Marston Green after
my Debts and the above said Legacys is Paid, all the
Remainder Part of my Estate both Real and Personal

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to him and his Heirs for ever whom I constitute and appoint
my sole & exclusive Executor of this most last will and Testament In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
Twelfth Day of November in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and Fifty eight.
