the sum of seventy six pounds fifteen shillings and four

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as touching such worldly Estate which it hath pleased  
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in the manner and form following Viz, I bequeath  
I give and Bequeath unto my son Jacob Williams of  
the Plantation whereon I now live to him and his  
heirs for ever on these Conditions that he pay unto his  
Sisters Anna Turpin and Elizabeth Wofeley or their heirs  
the sum of seventy six pounds thirteen shillings and four  
pence each Item I give and Bequeath unto my Grandson  
George Williamson son of George Williamson fifty pounds  
Item I give and Bequeath unto my Grand Daughter  
Elizabeth Williams Daughter of Thomas Williams fifty

From my own eye and signature unto my dear daughter  
Amy Murphy Daughter of William Williamson Fifty pounds  
Sterling I give and Bequeath unto my Daughters equally all  
my wearing Cloths and 2 Sets of Curtains from I give and  
Bequeath all the Remainder of my Estate Real and  
Personal to be Equally divided between my three Children  
now living vizt Jacob Williamson Elizabeth Mofely &  
Anne Surpen and to their heirs for ever and lastly  
I make and appoint my son Jacob Williamson &  
John Mofely my Executors of this my last Will and  
and Testament and I hereby revoking & Disannulling all  
Wills by me formerly made in Witness whereof the said  
Frances Williamson hath hereunto set her hand and Seal  
this thirtieth day of December One Thousand Seven hundred  
and Sixty Eight
