God do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form
as followeth. - First I give my Soul to god who gave the same to me and
my body to be buried at the Discretion of my Exors. hereafter named
Item I give and Bequeath to my Son James Bagley and to his heirs
and assigns forever One Negro fellow named Morica which he
has now in possession. - Item I give and bequeath to my Son
George Bagley and to his heirs and assigns forever One negro
fellow named Jack which he has now in possession Item I give
and bequeath to Anderson Bagley and to his heirs and assigns for
ever One negro boy named York and two hundred acres of land
lying on the head of Cold Water including the plantation
whereon Matthew Wornack formerly lived in Amelia County as
also after my wifes Decease or Widowhood I give to the Said
Anderson and to his heirs and assigns forever Two hundred & fifteen
acres of land including the plantation whereon I now live -
Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Bagley
the negro girl called Tab with all her Increase to her & her heirs
for ever Item I give and Bequeath to Dickerson Jennings

the negro girl called Tab with all her Increase to her & her heirs
for ever Item I give and Bequeath to Dickerson Jennings
who married my Daughter Frances One negro girl called
Usay with all her Increase to him and his heirs for ever
Item I give and Bequeath unto my Grandson William Sigon
Son of William Sigon when he comes to be of the age of twenty
One years or married Ninety pounds to be raised out of my
negro wench named Lucy and her Increase and my Will and
Desire is that if the said William Sigon should die before he comes
of age that the said Negro Wench and her Increase should be equally
Divided Between the above Named five Children it is James George
Anderson, Elizabeth Bagley and Dickerson Jennings Item I
leave to my Dear Beloved wife During of her Natural life or
Widowhood Two negroes Vizt Jeff & Hannah and the land &
plantation whereon I now live with all my Stock and household
Goods to enable her to raise my small Children and to pay
my Debts and after my wifes Decease my Will and Desire is
that the two above mentioned Negroes Jeff & Hannah likewise
the Negro Wench Lucy and her Increase after the Ninety

and is to be Equally Divided Between the five Children before named.
I do appoint my Dearly Beloved wife and my Son James Bagley
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament Witness my hand and
Seal this Twenty Ninth Day of December One thousand seven hundred
Eighty 1768.
