Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Savannah Green my Entry
of Land on Ballingers Creek in Goochland County. And my
Widow and heres that is at Abraham Eades in Goochland County
I have several other Articles in this County which I desire may be
gathered together and sold for ready money to Discharge my funeral
Charges and other charges in my sickness If there is any thing
remaining I desire my Daughter Savannah Green may have it -
I have in Samuel Jones's hands Two hundred pounds of Tob.
I have at Henry Lesters a saddle and girth Three tin pans & papers
with a bit in it and a pair of Shirts & a Blanket & a leather pair
and a hat if she can be had. I have at Emanuel Jones's a faying
pan and 900 Nails. I have at Hugh Lesters four yards and
a half of Virg. Cloath. I leave Will^m Commons my whole and Soul
