Possession of all my hole Estate Real and Personal in Duren her
Natal life and after her Decease to my Daughter Sally Smith to her
and Her Heires and Exhues Lawfully begotton by her Body for ever
and if she Dye without Heires Lawfully begot of her Body to be Equally
divided betw Isaac Duffo Children. I also apoynt Isaac Duffo and
John Cumton hole and Suel Exeute of this my last Will and
Testament ~~this 7 day~~ and I acknowledge this to be my last Will and
