last Will & Testament which was followeth.

Impremis I Give & bequeath unto my Son Josiah Grigg
ten Pound Current Money of Virginia.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Son William Grigg one
shilling sterling Money of great Britain.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth
Christopher one shilling sterling money of great Britain.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Son James Grigg five
negroes namely Peter Battis Sam Batt & Jude together
with ^{his} feather Beds & furniture to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Peter Grigg one
negro man named Jack during his natural life & after
his death to my Son James Grigg to his Heirs forever also
give him one feather bed & furniture.

Item I Give my loving Wife Frances Grigg the use of
four negroes namely old Jude, Robin, Mogg & Nancy to-
gether with all the rest of my Estate of every kind & nature
wha soever during her ^{it} natural life & after her Decease
I Give to my Son James Grigg to him & his Heirs forever
And lastly I Give to my Son James Grigg

whatsoever during her natural life & after her decease
I give it to my son James Grigg to him & his heirs forever
And lastly I do constitute & appoint my son James Grigg
sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament hereby
revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
Seal this twentieth day of February anno Dom 1764

Security as the said direct certificate was wanted him
