

In the name of God Amen Amelia County Wills 1730-1781
www.virginiapioneers.net I, the Parish of Nottoway in the
County of Amelia, do make in body, yet of sound and Perfect Understanding and memory
do constitute this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following *Yiz*

Item I Give and bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth Munford a Thousand Acres of Land on the
lower side of the Sweethouse Creek including the Plantation during her Natural life.
And after her decease to my son William Munford and his heirs forever *likewise*
I Give to my said wife all my Negroes which is now on the said plantation two excepted *namely* Peter and Fanny
which is hereafter given to my son Robert. Likewise I Give my said wife all my house hold
furniture together with all my stocks of cattle, hogs, and horses *likewise* I Give my said wife
one Doz of Silver Spoons which have the Arms of the Dolling family on them

Item I Give the remainder which is the lower part of my tract of land quantity eight hundred
or fifteen Acres or thereabouts on the Sweethouse Creek joining the lines of Thomas Booth, Wood
Jones, the Sweethouse Creek, and thence by direct line for 21 to my son namely David Holt and
Robert Munford and their heirs forever. I Trust and further it is my will and desire they
sell it to the best Advantage and the money arising from the sale of the said land to be
appropriated for the payment of my Debts

Item I Give and bequeath to Rich^d White son of Elisha White four hundred Acres of Land in one
corner of a tract which was surveyed between Samuel Gordon and my self on the line of
Seneca Creek in the County of Lunenburg to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give and bequeath to my son Robert Munford the Remainder of my Part of that Tract
of Land surveyed between Samuel Gordon and myself on the line of Seneca Creek in the
County of Lunenburg to him and his heirs forever. Likewise I Give him one doz of Silver spoons
marked *RM* Likewise I Give him two Negro Slaves *Yiz* A Negro boy named Peter and
a negro Girl named Fanny to him and his heirs forever
It is my Will and desire that my Estate should not be appraised

And I do hereby constitute and appoint David Holt and my son Robert Munford Executors
of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this *fourteenth* Day of *March* Anno Domini 1764
