Garrett of Amelia County Being in good health of body and of sound
& perfect mind and memory praise be to god I make and ordain
this my present last will and testament in manner and form following
That is to say first and principally I commend my soul Into the hands
of Almighty God hoping Through the merits Death and passion of
my Saviour Jesus Christ to have full and free pardon of all my
sins and to without Everlasting life and my body I bequeath to the Earth
to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter
named and as touching the Disposition of all such temporal Estates
as it has pleased almighty God to bestow upon me I Give and
Dispose thereof as followeth the first I will that my Debt and funeral
Charges should be paid and Discharge I am to give unto my son
Charles Garrett my plantation that I now do live on with as much
of this line of land lying between the Herringman Slack as
I own the tract to the Gutley as I own the Gutley to the River
as the Gutley Gatch I also give unto him a young house or more at
the age of twenty one year old I am to give unto my son
John Garrett half the other part of the same tract of Land lying
and being in the fish between the Herringman Slack and the Gutley
I also give him a new gun I am to give unto my son
Stephen Garrett the other part of the same tract of Land lying
and being the upper part from my land down and adjoining to Col:
W^m Hennions line I also Give unto him a young house or more
at the age of twenty years old But provided that of my three sons
Charles Garrett or John Garrett or Stephen Garrett Should die without
their lawfully begotten then part of the land to fall to the other two
Brothers aforesaid and be equally divided I am to Give
unto my son Abraham Garrett and to my son Tho^s Garrett a tract
or parcel of Land lying and being upon back Shinn Creek adjoining

And to without ever lasting life and my body I commit to the earth
to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter
named and as touching the Disposition of all such temporal Estates
as it has pleased almighty God to bestow upon me I Give and
Dispose thereof as follows the first I will that my Debt and funeral
Charges should be paid and Discharge I am I do give unto my son
Charles Garrott my plantation that I now do live on with as much
of this tract of land lying between the perchemon Slack and
Down the Slack to the Gutty as I have the Gutty to the River
as the Gutty Goe the I will Give unto him a young horse or mare at
the Age of Twenty one Year old

I am I do give unto my son
John Garrott half the other part of the same tract of Land it lying
and being in the fork between the perchemon Slack and the Gutty
I also give him a new gun I am I do give unto my son
Stephen Garrott the other part of the same tract of Land it lying
and being the upper part from my son John and forning to Col.
W^m Kemmons line I also Give unto him a young horse or mare,
at the Age of Twenty Years old But provided that if any of my three sons
Charles Garrott or John Garrott or Stephen Garrott should dy without
their lawfully begotten their part of the land to fall to the other two
Brothers aforesaid and be Equally divided I am I do Give
unto my son Abraham Garrott and to my son Tho^r Garrott a tract
or parcel of Land lying and being upon buck Shinn Creek forning
Thomas Coventon and that to be Equally Divided Between them but
if three of them Dyeth without their lawfully begotten the whole part
or parcel of Land to fall to the other I also give unto each of them
a young horse or mare at the Age of Twenty one Year old I also do
give unto my son Abraham my old gun I am I do give unto
my son Isaac Garrott the plantation he now lives on I am
I do give unto my Daughter Nanney Garrott one feather Bed with

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signature to it I also do give unto her one Cow and Calf one Iron Stott and two
Butter Dishes I then do give unto my Sister Susan at Boston one
Cow and Calf I then do make and ordain my loving wife Susan at
Garrett and my son Isaac Garrett my full and Sole Executors of this my
last will and Testament wherein I have set my hand and Seal the day and
Year above mentioned
