e perfect mind and memory praise be to god I do make and ordain

This my present last will and testament in manner and form following
That is to say first and principally I commend my soul unto the hands
of Almighty God hoping through the merits Death and passion of
my Saviour Jesus Christ to have full and free pardon of all my

sins and to attain everlasting life and my body I commend to the earth
to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter

named and concerning the disposition of all such temporal Estates
as it shall please almighty God to bestow upon me I give and
Dispose thereof as follows the first will that my Deth and funeral

Charges should be paid and discharge I am also give unto my son
Charles Garnett my plantation that when he live on with as much
of this kind of land byning to das far in the preeemore slack so
Down the slack to the Cutley or Dye the Cutley to the river
at the Cutley Charles I also give unto him a young house or more at
the age of twenty one year old

I am also give unto my son
John Garnett half the other part of the same tract of Land it lying
and being in the fish between the preeemore slack and the Cutley

I also give him a new gun

I am also give unto my son
Stephen Garnett the other part of the same tract of Land it lying
and being the upper part from my slack and joining to Cutley

W^m Hennings live I also give unto him a young house or more
at the age of twenty years old But provision there of my three sons

Charles Garnett or John Garnett or Stephen Garnett should die without
their lawfully begotten their part of the land to fall to the other two

Brothers aforesaid and be equally divided

I am also give
unto my son Abraham Garnett and to my son Etho^r Garnett a tract

of land lying and being upon back stream side sayng

time and to without ever lasting life and my body to come next to the earth

to be decently Buried at the ^{America County Mills 1734-1781} www.virginiapioneers.net grave place of my Soccetere hereafter named and as touching the Disposition of all such temporal Estates as it has pleased almighty God to bestow upon me & Give and Dispose thereof as follows the first wife that my Deceased funeral Charges should be paid and I am also give unto my son Charles Garrett my plantation that I now do live on with as much of this tract of land lying to the westward of the person or slack so down the said to the Galley or Person side Cuttley to the river at the Galley Gorge & also give unto him a young horse or mare at the age of Twenty one year old I am also give unto my son John Garrett half the other part of the same tract of Land lying and being in the part between the person or slack and the Cuttley also give him a new gun I am also give unto my son Stephen Garrett the other part of the same tract of Land lying and being the upper part from my plantation and joining to Col. Wm. Hemmings line & also Give unto him a young horse or mare at the age of Twenty years old But provision shall be made if my three sons Charles Garrett or John Garrett or Stephen Garrett should die without their lawfully begotten son part of the land to fall to the other two Brothers aforesaid and be equally divided I am also give unto my son Abraham Garrett and to my son Thos. Garrett a tract or parcell of Land lying and being upon back them feet by surveying Thomas Cowton and that to be Equally Divided Between them but if either of them Dyeth without their lawfully begotten the whole tract or parcell of Land so fall to the other I also give unto each of them a Young horse or mare at the age of Twenty one years old I also do give unto my son Abraham my old gun I am also give unto my son Isaac Garrett the plantation he now lives on I am also give unto my daughter Nancy Garrett one fother Bed with

signature to it I will do give unto her one Cow and Calf one from Scott and two
pewter Dishes. I have also given unto my Daughters Susan at Burton one
Cow and Calf. I have also made and dictated my loving Wifes Lisanne
Lynton and my son Isaac Garrett my full and sole Executress of this my
last will and Testament which cause to Shad be set my hand and Seal the day and
Year above mentioned.
