ever kind or nature it be I send to my Wife during her life &=
after her decease to be equally divided between my son John &=
my son Zachariah & my son Abner & my Daughter Holey &=
my Daughter Idea & my Daughter Tamer & my Daughter -
Amey. In premis I give & devise to my Daughter agnes Brn-
the one shilling. I give & devise to my Daughter Mary Jotly =
one shilling. Lastly I do nominate & appoint my son John =
Heaston & my Wife Executors of this my last Will & Testament
& I do hereby Revoke Disannul & make void all & every Will &=
Wills by me at any time heretofore made & I declare this this
& no other to be my last Will & Testament is witness where of
I have hereunto set my Hand & Affixed my Seal the day & Year
