1748. I John Jones of Ringhley Parish in the County of Amelia being very
sick and weak of Body, but of perfect mind and Memory do make and
ordain this my Last Will and Testament That is to say Principally and
first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the Hands of God that gave
it And for my Body I commend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian
like manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named
And as for my worldly Estate I give devise and dispose of I manner
and form following. In primis I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter
Elizabeth the wife of Nicholas Durnin one Shilling Sterling to be paid out
of my Estate to her and her Heirs for ever. Item I Give and Bequeath
to my Beloved Wife Mary after my just Debts are fully satisfied and
paid my Land and Moveables that is all my Estate both Real and
Personal to be at her Disposall for her Support as she shall think
proper to her and her Heirs for ever. I License constitute and ordain
me and Wife whole and sole Executors of this my Last Will and Testament
And do hereby disannul disallow Revoke and make void all other
or former Wills and Legacies Testaments Bequests and Executions by me
in any ways before this time made Ratifying and confirming this to
be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal the day and Year above Written

or former Wills and Legacies Testaments Bequests and Executions by me
