In the Name of God Amen I the undersigned John Lovell of Amelia County being health and perfect memory do give to my well beloved son George the Plantation whereon I now live with one Hundred Acres of Land belonging thereto I likewise give to my well beloved son David one hundred Acres of Land adjoining Thomas Ashland and Abraham Woodruffs line

I likewise give to my well beloved son William one Hundred Acres of Land adjoining John Granfords line and Richard Dornings line to be Equally divided on Wills of my hand and Seal this 1st day of Decem^r 1744 one Thousand seven Hundred and forty four
