ever fifty Acres of Land adjoining that I gave to my Son Mark

Item my Will and Desire is that my Dear beloved wife have the
whole use of my Plantation and fifty Acres of Land

Adjoining the same during her Natural life and then I give the
Same to my Son [redacted] and to his heirs and Assigns forever

and do appoint [redacted] my dear beloved wife my whole Executors of
this my last will & Testament Witness my hand and seal this
