and Parish of Raleigh being Sick & weak of Body but of a disposing
mind and memory thanks be to god Do make & ordain this my last
will and Testament in manner and form as followeth Viz
First I leave and lend unto my loving wife Mary Old the
Plantation I now live on and the Profit of my two negros namely
Sammy and Lucy five head of Cattle ten head of Hogs one
feather bed and furniture one horse & side saddle three pewter
dishes half a Dozen of plates and two Basons two Iron Pots
and one Brass Kettle all which I lend unto her During her
natural life and then to descend as followeth Also I give &
bequeath unto my son James Old one Tract of land as I have
made him a Deed for an White Oak Creek also one negro

feather bed and Turniture and One Iron Bedstead
 Dishes half a dozen of Plates two pewter Plates and
 hath Atriads received only the cattle & hogs to him & his heirs
 & assigns for ever. Also I give to my son James the
 tract of land which I have made him a Despoinding
 my son James also one negro first named Bill one Cow
 & half one horse Bridle & saddle one shew & pig & one
 feather bed & Turniture three pewter Dishes half a dozen
 of Plates & two Basons & one Iron pole which he has received
 to him & his heirs & assigns for ever. Also I give the quarter
 to my son John Old all the land I have in Quindarie
 County on white Oak Creek which I purchased of Rees
 Ford & Davis containing five hundred & fifteen Acres also my
 Cow Horse & my Bridle & saddle also one negro girl -
 Named Ellis one feather Bed & Turniture one Cow & half
 one shew & pig three pewter Dishes half a dozen of Plates
 two pewter Basons & one Iron pole to him & his heirs & assigns
 forever. Also I give & Bequeath to my son William Old the
 tract of land I now live on containing two hundred & twenty
 Acres to him & his heirs & assigns forever. Also I give & Bequeath
 to my son Thomas Old & Joshua Old

forever. Also I give & Bequeath to my son William
Plantation I now live on containing two hundred & twenty
Acres & to my sons Charles Old Thomas Old & Joshua Old
Six hundred & twenty five Acres of Land on Rocky Run to
be equally divided But the lower lot to have two hundred
one ~~of my negro~~ ^{my negro} ~~to be one of their lots~~ ^{also each of them}
twenty five Acres ~~Also~~ ^{each of them} a horse bridle & Saddle
& one Feather Bed & furniture one Cow & Calf & one sow
& Pigs three Dishes half a Dozen of plates two Basins
& One Iron pot to them & their heirs & assigns forever
Also I give & bequeath to my Daughter Ann Clay One
Negro boy named Ralph Also one Feather Bed & furniture
One Cow & Calf one sow & Pigs three Center Dishes half
a Dozen of Plates two Basins one Iron pot which she has
Received to them & their heirs for ever Also I give & bequeath
to my Daughter Sarah Tucker my negro Boy Daniel one
feather Bed & furniture One Cow & Calf One sow & Pigs
three Center Dishes half a Dozen of Plates & two Center
Basins Also One side Saddle One pot which she hath
Already Received to her & her heirs & assigns for ever

My last will & testament I leave to my daughter
half one cow & pig three pewter dishes half a dozen of plates two
two basins also one side saddle to her other hairs and
also I give & bequeath to my daughter one cow &
man also one feather bed & furniture one cow &
one pig three pewter dishes half a dozen of plates two
pewter basins also one side saddle to her other hairs and
aprons for ever. Also I give & bequeath to my daughter one
old one young negro one feather bed & furniture one cow &
half one cow & pig three pewter dishes half a dozen of plates
two basins & one side saddle to her other hairs for ever
Also I give & bequeath to my daughter one cow &
negro one feather bed & furniture one cow & half one cow &
pig three pewter dishes half a dozen of plates two basins &
one side saddle to her & her hairs for ever. Also my will &
desire is that after the mentioned legacies are paid off that the
Remainder part of my Estate be equally divided among all
my children when my son John is fifteen years of age &
my desire is that my son James old may have my shoe brots
chairs to be equally divided -

my desire is that my son James Old may have
all the rest of my Woollen Cloaths to be equally Divided -
Between my sons James & Edward Old, all but my Dear
Great Coat that I give to my son John and my Desire is
that my son John Old may have a Dwelling house such as
my son James hath and my desire is that all my three
Youngest Sons have such Dwelling houses as my son James
& my Sons I desire may have five years Schooling a piece
& my Girls two years a piece & the Building of the houses &
Schooling of my Children be paid out of my Estate before any
Division & then what is left to be equally Divided amongst
my Children And I appoint my loving Wife Mary Old and
James Old & Edward Old executors to this my Last Will
& Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & Seal this 8th day of March 1767.
