brother thinks fit Item I give to my loving brother  
Archibald Yarbrough the rest of my Land which is  
Three hundred Acres together with one Negro  
named Roben and all the rest of my Estate both  
Reale and Personel to him and his heirs he paying  
my Debts I do revoke all Wills by me heretofore  
made & do make constitute and appoint Marston  
Green and my loving brother Executors of this my  
last
