Amelia County Wills 1734-1761
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I Judith Booker Relict of Edward Booker of Amelia County late Deceased, being of sound and perfect memory tho' deprived of speech Do make this my last Will and Testament in manner following

My Soul I surrender to God the Great Creator of all things. Trusting in the merits of my Blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to receive forgiveness for all my sins, and my body to be buried as my Executors shall direct, as for what worldly Estate I have or of Right to me doth belong I give and bequeath the same to my Daughter Judith Booker and to her Heirs forever Except my wearing apparel I mean such as I have already worn my Will is that the same be equally divided among my four Daughters But my intent and meaning is that my Daughter, Judith shall have all the New Goods that is not already made up or such as I have not already worn

My desire is that my said Daughter Judith may live with and under the Care and Jurisdiction of Mr. Cobbs the Wife of Sam^l Cobbs. and that there be no Appraisement of my Estate And lastly I do Constitute and appoint my Brother William Archer and my friend Sam^l Cobbs Executors of this my last Will unto which I have set my hand and Seal this fourteenth day of December One thousand Seven hundred and fifty Judith + Booker

At a Court held for Amelia County the 18th Day of January 1750
