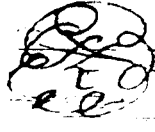


In the Name of God Amen I Martin Dudley of the

constitute and make this my last Will and Testament in
manner following first I give my Soul to God that gave
it in sure and certain hope of its I. resurrection and eter-
nal Life and for what worldly goods it has been pleased God
to bestow on me with I give in manner as follows.

I leave the Land I bought of M^r. Samuel Tarry to be sold unless
he will receive the deed made to me back and give up my
Bond to my Executors hereafter named In that case the Land
is to be M^r. Tarrys again and all the rest of my Estate after
paying my Funeral charges & just debts I lend to my lov-
ing Wife Anna Maria Dudley during her natural Life that
it should be understood the most part of all my slaves which
I desire my Executors may have the whole good management

I desire my Executors may have the whole & good management
of either of them during the life of my said Wife & if she
should prove with Child by me my Will & desire is, that
after her decease, my whole Estate aforesaid may go to
that child, and if that should die with^{out} issue lawfully
begotten, then my desire is, after the decease of my Wife
aforesaid that my whole Estate be equally divided between
Wm. Eger Moulson, Son of my sister Mary Moulson &
Joseph Eggleston Son of my Sister Judith Eggleston & if
either of those Boys die without issue lawfully begotten
then my will is that such deceaseds part of my Estate
shall be equally divided between his surviving Sisters
I give my loving Wife Anna Maria Dudley my
Horse one romans Saddle & bridle one bed & the furniture
with one desk & Book case her Trunk, China Ware &
all the Tea Trunkets, all which I desire may not be
appraised
