payment well & truly to be made we bind ourselves our
Heirs Executors & Admins jointly & severally firmly by these
presents sealed with our seals & dated this 17 Day of
April 1782.

Whereas a Marriage is shortly intended
to be solemnized between the above bound Adam
Jones and Nancy Harrison of Natronay parish
Now the Condition of the presents obligation is
such that there be no lawful Cause to obstruct
the said Marriage then the said Obligation is to be
void otherwise to remain in full force.
