Do Ordain and appoint this my last Will and Testament
In Manner following -

I have committed my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who
give it me and my Body to the Earth to be buried at the
Discretion of my Executor hereafter named
I Give and bequeath to my Brother Edward Jones a new one
Negro man named Duglass once my own man named
Maurice and one young Boy named Anthony who are
to sit down with their families to live and die
free forever And further my will is that in consideration
of the above I give my Brother Edward Jones pay up to my own
Debt Mary Jones and Martha Jones Daughters of Edward

Jones the sum of twenty five pounds Current money of
Virginia to each of them when they or either of them shall attain
to the age of ten Years And in case either the said Mary or
Martha should Depart this life before they attain to that
age then the surviving sister to have the whole fifty pounds
I Give and bequeath to my Brother John Jones once my
Boy named William and my Son John I wish them well
forever.

I Give and bequeath to the aforesaid Mary Jones Daughter

inter & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who
give it me and my Body to the earth to be buried at the
Discretion of my Executors hereafter named
I Give and bequeath to my Brother Cadwallader Jones one
Negro man named Duplan, one Negro woman named
Annabel and two Negro Boys named Anthony & so on
I Give and bequeath to my Brother Cadwallader Jones
the sum of twenty five pounds current money of
Virginia to each of them when they or either of them shall attain
to the age of ten Years And whereas the said Mary or
Martha should Depart this life before they attain to that
age then the Surviving Sister to have the whole fifty pounds
I Give and bequeath to my Brother Peter Jones one Negro
Boy named William and my Son I wish him well here
forever
I Give and bequeath to the aforesaid Mary Jones Daughter
of Cad and Jones one Feather Bed and furniture to her and
her heirs forever
I likewise appoint my two Brothers Cadwallader Jones
and Peter Jones Executors of this my last Will and Testament
Revoking Disannulling and making void all other or former Wills
Wills by me heretofore made, and this and no other to be my last
Will and Testament.
