pleased God to bless me in this life I do give bequeath
of the same in the following manner and form
First I give and bequeath to my beloved Sister Martha

have my share in a grace and her share in it
after paying me my debts

I Recommend to my beloved Sister Elizabeth Cary all my
moving apparel and also confirming this and no other
to be my last Will and Testament I also appoint my
beloved Sister Martha Goosley whole and sole executrix of
this my last Will & Testament as Witness my seal
this sixteen Day of April 1767.
