wheron I now live. I am I leave what Personal Estate is left me in
Chesterfield County as well as what it has please^d God to Indue me with
in this County to the wife of my living Wife as well the Slaves as the other
part of my Estate for the support of my Wife and Children and when my
Children com of age or marryd Then to be Equally Devided among them
And I do hereby Constitute and Appoint my wife and her Brother Henry
Swain and Joseph Farley Jun^r Exec^r with my wife Exec^r of this my
last Will and Testament Whereunto I have set my hand and Seal this
Twenty-second Day of August One thousand seven hundred and fifty.
